

## United Ilocano Association of Tidewater Inc. Scholastic Achievement Awards and Scholarships

The United Ilocano Association of Tidewater Inc. announces its annual search for outstanding Filipino-American students of Hampton Roads for the 2023-2024 academic year. We are pleased to recognize the academic and community achievements of the Filipino-American youth in Hampton Roads with the following available awards.

I. Graduating high school senior students

Eligible graduating high school seniors must be of Filipino-American heritage, a resident of Hampton Roads, a full-time high school senior during the 2023-2024 academic year in an accredited high school in Hampton Roads, and entering a college or vocational/technical school following graduation.

- A. MOST OUTSTANDING UIAT HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATE
  - Graduating high school seniors who are active members of UIAT <u>for at least two years immediately</u> <u>prior to application</u> are eligible for a scholarship up to \$1000.
- B. MOST OUTSTANDING FILIPINO-AMERICAN HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATE Graduating Filipino-American high school seniors are eligible for a scholarship award up to \$500.
- C. DR. ERLINDA R. RAMISCAL MEMORIAL FILIPINO-AMERICAN SCHOLARSHIP Graduating Filipino-American high school seniors with outstanding leadership abilities, community service and talents, as well as good academic standing are eligible for a scholarship award of \$1000.
   D. Additional scholarship awards are available as warranted
- D. Additional scholarship awards are available as warranted.

II. Elementary through high school scholastic achievement awards

Eligible students in grades 1 through 11 must be UIAT members, residents of Hampton Roads, and attending an accredited school in Hampton Roads during the 2023-2024 academic year.

A. MOST OUTSTANDING UIAT STUDENTS FOR ELEMENTARY THROUGH HIGH SCHOOL UIAT Inc. member students in grades 1 through 11 are eligible for monetary awards and achievement certificates.
